## **How Does 46 "Deaths" In Four Years Grab You?**

Eighteen microbiologists die in suspicious circumstances in just four months, forty six in four years.

Some of them world leaders in developing weapons-grade biological plagues.

Others the best in how to protect millions from dying because of biological weapons.

Still others, experts in the theory of bioterrorism.

Add a sprinkle of Russian defectors, some nervy U.S. biotech companies, a deranged assassin or three, a bit of Elvis, several Manson style Satanists, a subtle hint of espionage, a baseball bat, several planes, a bomb with a faulty timer stir in Men in Black, Government Assassins, and the plot is complete.

If they tried to film it, it wouldn't get past the reading stage, "Please make your plots more believable!"

**Accident or Murder? Here Is Part Of The List - You Make Up Your Own Mind**

**November 12, 2001: The Start! The deaths of renowned microbiologists.**

The first dead microbiologist is Dr. Benito Que, 52, was "an expert in infectious diseases and cellular biology at the Miami Medical School.

Police originally suspected that he had been beaten on November 12 in a carjacking in the medical school's parking lot.

But his body showed no signs of a beating. Then they suspected a stroke." [G & M, 5/4/02]

**November 16, 2001: Dead microbiologist: Dr. Don Wiley, 57, disappears during a trip to Memphis, Tennessee.** [Fox News, 11/24/01]

Although he had just bought tickets to take his son to Graceland the following day, police found his car on a bridge and his body was later found in the Mississippi River.

Forensic experts said he may have had a dizzy spell and fallen off the bridge. Police say, "We began this as a missing person investigation. From there it went to a more criminal bent." [CNN, 11/29/01]

Wiley was one of the world's leading researchers of deadly viruses, including HIV and the Ebola virus." [CNN, 12/22/01] - The FBI is monitoring the investigation because of his research knowledge. [G & M, 5/4/02]

**November 21, 2001 (B): Dead microbiologist: World renowned microbiologist and high-profile Russian defector Dr. Vladimir Pasechnik, 64, dies of a stroke.**

Pasechnik defected to Britain in 1989, and previously had played a huge role in the development of Russian bio warfare, heading a lab of 400 "with an unlimited budget" and "the best staff available."

**Weapons of mass destruction inspector Dr David Kelly had approached publishers just before his mysterious suicide/death offering them a book exposing highly damaging world government secrets.**

He had been in discussion with a publisher in Oxford and had sought advice as to how far he could go without breaking the secrecy laws.

After his death, his computers were seized and it is still not known if any rough draft was discovered by investigators and, if so, what happened to the material.

Dr Kelly was also intending to expose a potentially bigger scandal, his own secret dealings in germ warfare with the apartheid regime

He says he succeeded in producing an aerosolized plague microbe that could survive outside the laboratory.

He was connected to Britain's spy agency and recently had started his own company. "In the last few weeks of his life he had put his research on anthrax at the disposal of the [British] Government, in the light of the threat from bioterrorism." [London Times, 11/30/01, New York Times, 11/23/01, G & M, 5/4/02]

**November 24, 2001: Three more dead microbiologists: A Swissair flight from Berlin to Zurich crashes during its landing approach; 22 are killed and nine survive.**

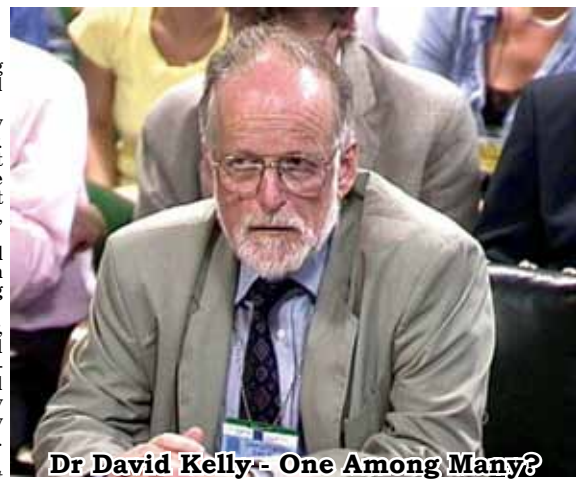
Among the dead are Dr. Yaakov Matzner, 54, dean of the Hebrew University school of medicine; Amiramp Eldor, 59, world-recognized expert in blood clotting and head of the haematology department in Tel Aviv and Avishai Berkman, 50, director of Tel Aviv public health department and businessman. [CNN, 11/25/01, Swissair manifest, 11/24/01]

**Witness Franz Brunner, a local government official, told state television: "I was walking my dog when I saw the plane. It appeared to be flying low. Then the sky turned bright orange, as if there was a sudden ball of fire."**

**December 10, 2001: Dead microbiologist: "Dr. Robert Schwartz, 57, was stabbed with a sword in his farmhouse in Leesberg, Virginia.**

His daughter says she's a pagan high priestess of a coven practicing magic and self-mutilation and she, and three of her fellow pagans have been charged." [G & M, 5/4/02]

**February 11, 2002: Dead microbiologist: Dr. Ian Langford, 40, is found dead, partially naked and wedged under a chair in his home in Norwich, England.**

When found, his house was described as "blood-spattered and apparently ransacked."

He was an expert in environmental risks and disease and a senior Fellow at the University of East Anglia's Centre for Research on the Environment.

A colleague said, "Ian was without doubt one of Europe's leading experts on environmental risk, specializing in links between human health and environmental risk... One of the most brilliant colleagues I have ever had." [London Times, 2/13/02, G & M, 5/4/02]

**February 28, 2002 (B): Two dead microbiologists in San Francisco.**

While taking delivery of a pizza, Tanya Holzmayer, 46, is shot and killed by a colleague, Guyang Huang, 38, who then apparently shot himself.

Holzmayer moved to the US from Russia in 1989. Her research focused on the part of the human molecular structure that could be affected best by medicine.

Holzmayer was focusing on helping create new drugs that interfere with replication of the virus that causes AIDS.

One year earlier, Holzmayer carried out management orders to fire Huang. [San Jose Mercury News, 2/28/02, G & M, 5/4/02]

**March 24, 2002 (C): Dead microbiologist: David Wynn-Williams, 55, is hit by a car while jogging near his home in Cambridge, England.**

He was an astrobiologist with the Antarctic Astrobiology Project and the NASA Ames Research Centre.

He was studying the capability of microbes to adapt to environmental extremes, including the bombardment of ultraviolet rays and global warming. [London Times, 3/27/02, Guardian 15/4]

**March 25, 2002: Dead microbiologist: Steven Mostow, 63. The airplane he was piloting crashed near Denver, Colorado.**

He worked at the Colorado Health Sciences Centre and was known as "Dr. Flu" for his expertise in treating influenza, and expertise on bioterrorism.

Mostow was "one of the country's leading infectious disease experts" and was associate dean at the University of Colorado Health Sciences Centre.

Three others died in the crash.

Witnesses say they saw the plane go down. "As we came over the hill we saw the plane coming straight toward the highway actually, and swerving from side to side, losing altitude fast,"

Willen Guyer said. "I think the guy saw the highway and turned away from it and when he turned left he just went nose down into the ground."

Mostow's death brings the total number of leading microbiologists killed in a six-month period to sixteen. [KUSA TV, 3/26/02, G & M, 5/4/02] **Please Note: G & M are the Canadian Globe and Mail offering the most authoritative national and international news.**

Dr Kelly was found dead, exactly as he had predicted, in woods near his Oxfordshire home on July 17 2003.

This apparent suicide came two days after he was interrogated in the House of Commons over his role in exposing the flaws in the "sexed-up" Number 10 dossier which justified Britain going to war with Iraq.

A group of doctors are calling for an inquest into the death of David Kelly, insisting the verdict of suicide should be overturned.

There has been no coroner's inquest into Dr David Kelly's death, the specialist medics say the Hutton Inquiry's finding of suicide was flawed.



**Anthrax Letters - USA**  
In the days following 9/11, Anthrax-laced letters, mailed to media and U.S. senators, killed five people and spread fear and panic throughout the nation.

Schwartz, who was a single parent and said to be very close to his children.

Schwartz worked at Virginia's Centre for Innovative Technology on DNA sequencing and pathogenic microorganisms.

He was "a brilliant scientist who had a gift for explaining complex scientific subjects in simple language." [Washington Post, 12/12/01]

**December 14, 2001: Dead microbiologist: Nguyen Van Set, 44, dies in an airlock filled with nitrogen in his lab in Geelong, Australia.**

The lab had just been featured in the journal "Nature" for its work in genetic manipulation and DNA sequencing.

Nature reported, "Scientists there had created a virulent form of mouse pox.

"They realized that if similar genetic manipulation was carried out on smallpox, an unstoppable killer could be unleashed." [Sydney Morning Herald, 12/12/01, G & M, 5/4/02]

**January 2002: Two dead microbiologists: Ivan Glebov and Alexi Brushlinski.**

Pravda reports that Glebov died as the result of a bandit attack and offers no explanation as to why Brushlinski was also killed in Moscow.

Both were "well known around the world" and members of the Russian Academy of Science. [Pravda, 2/9/02, G & M, 5/4/02]

**February 9, 2002 (B): Dead microbiologist: Victor Korshunov, 56, is hit over the head and killed at the entrance of his home in Moscow, Russia.**

He was the head of the microbiology sub-in South Africa.

US television investigators spent four years preparing a 90-minute documentary, Anthrax War, suggesting there is a global black market in anthrax and exposing the mystery "suicides" of five government germ warfare scientists from around the world.

Film director Bob Coen said: "The deeper you look into the murky world of governments and germ warfare, the more worrying it becomes.

"We have proved there is a black market in anthrax. David Kelly was of particular interest to us because he was a world expert on anthrax and he was involved in some degree with assisting the secret germ warfare programme in apartheid
